- The supplier must request testing and have completed all PA PUC licensing and Duquesne requirements at least 30 days before the test date commencement. The registration material's due dates are listed above. Failure to meet the requirement can delay testing to the next block. - Certification testing with Duquesne is not done using GISB1.4.
- NAESB I.6 has been standard in PA since 2006, adhering to Internet EDI plan version 2.0.
- Connectivity testing for both inbound and outbound EDI transactions must be completed with Duquesne before the start date of your scheduled EDI test block. Please schedule the connectivity test at least three business days in advance.
